Preamble

Amidst the COVID -19 pandemic & under the uncertainties & the debates prevailing, the authorities decide to open Sri Siddhartha Institute of Medical Sciences & Research Centre, at T. Begur, Nelamangala Taluk, Bangalore Rural from 9th Jan 2021 with the Fresher's Program followed by starting of classes from 11th Jan 2021 under the standard guidelines of the apex body & the Central / State Government.

The proposed guidelines can be modifiable depending on the need & demand of the situation & also can be updated in accordance with the periodically released advisories / guidelines from WHO & other concerned authorities.

Students & the parents are hereby informed to completely understand the existing situation of COVID - 19 pandemic & its sequelae & cooperate with the institution for better outcome of their wards academic growth.

Instructions to Students

(Applicable for both Hostel inmates & Day scholars)

General Preventive Measures

- 1. Physical distancing of at least 6 feet as far as feasible.
- 2. Mandatory use of face cover / Masks.
- 3. Frequent hand washing with soap for 40 60 Secs (Once in 2 hours) or Use alcohol-based hand sanitizers for 20 Secs, once an hour while in the classes.
- 4. Respiratory etiquettes are to be strictly followed with proper disposal of used tissues. This involves strict practice of covering one's mouth and nose with a tissue paper while coughing / sneezing over flexed elbow / shoulder and disposing the used tissues properly in the designated places.
- 5. Self-Monitoring of health & reporting of any illness at the earliest to the concerned authorities.
- 6. Spitting to be strictly prohibited.
- 7. Installation & use of Arogya Setu App is compulsory.

Before Entering the Campus:

- a. Students & staff are strictly instructed not to visit areas falling within containment zones.
- b. Prior information regarding joining to the institution is mandatory.
- c. Students must compulsorily produce RT-PCR, COVID-19 Negative test report done in authorized ICMR approved laboratories at least three days prior to joining. (i,e, the test should be conducted between 5th to 7th of Jan 2021 if the joining is on 8th Jan 2021. Other forms of testing for COVID 19 are not acceptable.
- d. Both Student & the parent shall give the declaration / undertaking in the specified format annexed.
- e. Students are hereby requested to get their own dinning plate, spoon, bowl, tea cup, water drinking glasses etc. for their use in the prevailing corona pandemic.
- f. Central library & canteen are closed for students.
- g. Students can visit the hospital when they are ill.

During Stay in Campus

- a) Hostel inmates are expected to stay in the hostel for 2 days following joining & ensure that the necessary arrangements including cleanliness of room & toilets are personally attended to & become physically / mentally fit to attend the teaching sessions from the 3rd day.
- b) All general preventive measures listed are to be followed strictly.
- c) Outside eateries / soft drinks are strictly prohibited.
- d) Zero tolerance for smoking, alcoholism, narcotic drug / substance abuse.
- e) Student movements are strictly restricted only to the campus in the current scenario.
- f) Parents / Guardians / Friends are strictly prohibited from meeting the students in the prevailing situations.
- g) Crowding, walking in groups, celebrations of any kind either within or outside the hostel / campus is not permitted.
- h) Student can attend to emergencies under permission by the warden / Assistant warden.
- i) Entry to other rooms of the hostel is prohibited.
- j) Student suffering from any illness requiring hospitalization will be admitted to the affiliating teaching hospital & information will be sent to their parents for necessary action.
